RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Preparing financial statements for the non-profit branch, including balance sheets and income statements
- Updating the non-profit branch's financial journal
- Maintaining an online database of bank statements, cheque records, donation receipts, reimbursement paperwork and purchasing receipts
- Working alongside Director of Accounting and Managing Director to create an annual multi-thousand dollar budget
- Working alongside the grant writers to ensure funds are properly spent, according to granting organizations/donor guidelines
- Ensure Health Out Loud's mission and values are communicated all the way from the top down within the organization and that they are followed at all times



- Preparing reimbursement payments using Health Out Loud (HOL)'s standardized system, including verifying documentation and requesting disbursements
- Developing and implementing new financial policies and procedures that will be used by different HOL branches across the province
- Organizing and presenting an 'Accountant Training Day' session where all the accountants from every chapter are trained to use Health Out Loud's standardized accounting procedures through experiential learning techniques
- Providing mentorship and support to six different HOL branches throughout the year
- Conducting quarterly internal audits of financial documents to ensure accountability and accurate reporting of financial statuses to the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA), donors, granting organizations and Board of Directors
- Ensuring Health Out Loud is abiding by the CRA's policies for registered charities
- Attending bi-weekly sub-committee meetings
- Act as an ambassador and promote Health Out Loud at networking events, conferences or other external engagements

- Accounting experience/interest or studying an accounting/finance related field
- Proficient knowledge in Microsoft Office Suite (Excel, PowerPoint, Word)
- Leadership experience in work, student groups, or other organizations
